Online registration is coming to Limestone

The Limestone District School Board is excited to introduce online registration for our families in the new year.

New families or those returning to our district will soon be able to register online to attend school via our new online registration process. The new online tool will allow families to search their home address which will then provide the school catchment, or boundary, for their area and determine which school their child is eligible to attend.

All information provided through the online process is secure and will be confidentially transferred to the school for review to complete the registration process.

Accommodations will be made to help families navigate the new process should they require assistance.

The new online registration will be launched in February 2018. Watch for more details coming soon.

Karina, gr. 3: "I stayed healthy."


Pierce, gr. 4: "I didn't leave my house & it was nice. I also had a sleep-over with my cousins."
